While working full time and raising a young family, Alex returned to school to study graphic design where he earned his Associates Degree then went to complete his Bachelor of Fine Arts in Visual Communications from the International Academy of Design, graduating summa cum laude. Soon after, he founded the design business that would become Cranium Agency.

From its earliest days, Cranium worked with small businesses and established organizations across Iowa. Alex learned firsthand what it takes to build a business, meet a payroll, make difficult decisions, and earn the trust of clients through consistent work.
